Director's Corner

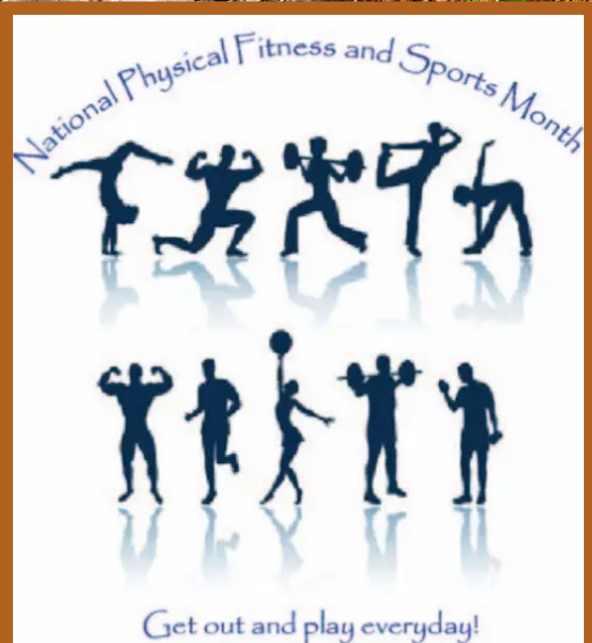

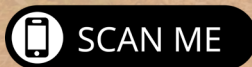
Build up... or be quiet!
